

PROMOTION RULES
2nd Chance
October 1 to November 3, 2019

1. DEFINITIONS

1.1. 2nd CHANCE PROMOTION (hereafter referred to as the “Promotion”):

Promotion held per the Sales promotion games By-law (CQLR, c. S – 13.1, r. 4).

1.2. LOTO-QUÉBEC:

The Société des loteries du Québec, responsible for organizing the Promotion.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Only individuals who are 18 years of age or older can take part in the Promotion provided they are residents of Québec.

To be eligible for the Promotion, entrants must be the legitimate holder of a Grande Vie lottery ticket purchased in Québec between 5 a.m. on October 1, 2019, and 11:59 p.m. on October 31, 2019, inclusively (hereafter referred to as the “Ticket”).

3. DURATION

The Promotion will run from 5 a.m. on October 1, 2019, to 11:59 p.m. on November 3, 2019. The draw will be conducted at approximately 1:30 p.m. on November 5, 2019.

4. HOW TO ENTER

4.1 Eligible entrants can take part in the Promotion free of charge, provided that they:

4.1.1 Purchased their Ticket online and were automatically entered in the Promotion, or

4.1.2 Scanned the QR code on their Ticket or entered the Ticket's control number using the mobile Lotteries app and registered for the Promotion by following instructions by 11:59 p.m. on November 3, 2019, or

4.1.3 Visited the Promotion page (lotoquebec.com/2chance) and registered for the Promotion by following instructions by 11:59 p.m. on November 3, 2019.

4.2 Registrations that are not completed by 11:59 p.m. on November 3, 2019, will be deemed null and void and will not be considered for the Promotion. The same holds true for any entry form that contains mistakes or is incomplete, fraudulent or otherwise violates the rules herein.

4.3 Only Québec residents can enter the Promotion online.

- 4.4 Each Grande Vie play will entitle entrants to three entries for the Promotion draw once registration is complete.

5. DRAW DETAILS AND PRIZE DESCRIPTION

- 5.1 The random draw will be conducted among all entries resulting from registrations completed within prescribed deadlines and in compliance with the conditions indicated in the rules herein.
- 5.2 The random electronic draw will be conducted using Loto-Québec's computer system in Loto-Québec's draw room in Montréal at around 1:30 p.m. on November 5, 2019.
- 5.3 The draw will be performed by the employee responsible for Loto-Québec's draws, under the supervision of an external auditor.
- 5.4 A Loto-Québec customer service employee will call the individual whose entry is selected to ask for proof of ID.

IN THE EVENT THAT THE ENTRY DRAWN IS DEEMED VALID AND COMPLIANT:

- 5.5 In the event that the entry drawn is deemed valid and compliant with the rules herein, the winner will receive the \$10,000 prize, provided that they submit to Loto-Québec one of the pieces of ID indicated in Section 6.2 herein within 72 hours following the request and that the information indicated thereon matches that provided by the winner when he or she entered the Promotion.

IN THE EVENT THAT THE ENTRY DRAWN IS DEEMED INVALID OR NON-COMPLIANT:

- 5.6 Should the entry drawn be deemed invalid or non-compliant with the rules herein, or the individual whose entry is selected did not submitted proof of ID as indicated in Section 5.5, that entry will be cancelled and another entry will be drawn at random. Such draws will be conducted until an entry is found to be valid and compliant, in which case the terms described in Section 5.5 above will apply.

6. HOW TO CLAIM A PRIZE

- 6.1 The eligible individual whose entry is selected must go in person to a designated Loto-Québec establishment (list available upon request or at lotoquebec.com) within one-year following the draw.
- 6.2 Loto-Québec will require the winner to fill out a claim form and submit one of the following pieces of ID:
- Health insurance card
 - Driver's licence
 - Passport
- 6.3 The prize will be remitted by cheque.

7. FIRST AND LAST NAME, REGION AND PHOTOGRAPH

The winner's first and last names, region and photo, as well as any other information voluntarily provided, can be used by Loto-Québec and its subsidiaries not only for the draw described in the rules herein, but also for advertising purposes, particularly on the Internet (including social media). Winners must waive all rights to broadcast, print or advertising compensation as well as any compensation of any kind whatsoever related to the draw.

8. INFORMATION GATHERING AND USE

By entering the Promotion, eligible individuals acknowledge that they have read and understood the terms and conditions herein, as well as Loto-Québec's confidentiality policy, to which they agree to abide by. By taking part in the Promotion, eligible individuals authorize Loto-Québec to gather, analyze use and maintain information on their Grande Vie lottery ticket purchases during the Promotion period. They further authorize Loto-Québec to send them offers matching those purchases, provided the individuals have ticked the specified box. Communications will be sent by email. Loto-Québec can use as it sees fit all data and information collected as part of this Promotion, provided that none of the information is linked to third parties and that the confidentiality and security of the collected personal information are protected.

9. OTHER RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS

- 9.1** The prize must be accepted "as is" and cannot be transferred or exchanged. Loto-Québec reserves the right to replace a prize with another of equal value.
- 9.2** Loto-Québec reserves the right to cancel or delay the Promotion, in whole or in part, without notice and for any reason whatsoever or due to an act of God or force majeure. Loto-Québec can also amend these rules at any time, in which case the amended rules will be made available to the public.
- 9.3** Loto-Québec declines all liability should the Promotion be cancelled, delayed or modified, or in the event of a computer system failure or malfunction.
- 9.4** Loto-Québec declines all responsibility towards anyone who did not receive one or more electronic entries or a chance to enter the Promotion.
- 9.5** Loto-Québec declines all responsibility in the event of the loss or theft of any Ticket, or any other incident or situation that prevents anyone from meeting deadlines or claiming a prize.
- 9.6** In the event that an entrant violates the rules herein, makes a false statement, attempts to cheat, commits fraud, acts in collusion or conspires with a third party, their entry will be automatically cancelled, and they will be ineligible for any other event related to the Promotion.

10. DISPUTES

Any dispute relating to this Promotion, whether regarding conduct and/or award of any prizes, will be settled according to the rules herein and the Sales Promotion Games By-law (CQLR, c. S – 13.1, r. 4).
