## Lotło Max and Québec Max "Combinaisons"

The Combinaisons (Combination) play is an easier and faster way to play several selections at once. It is only possible to buy one Combinaisons play at retail with a selection slip. The Combinaisons slip provides the opportunity to win several prizes simultaneously.

With the Combinaisons slip, you can play Lotto Max, Québec Max or Double Jeu Max (Lotto Max and Québec Max). This slip may be used to play 6,8 or 9 numbers. You can choose your numbers or opt for Quick Pick (selection randomly generated by the Loto-Québec computer). The computer will generate all possible 7 -number selections using the 6,8 or 9 numbers of your combination.

It is possible to participate in up to 4 straight draws with the same selection slip.
Extra is available with the Lotto Max and Québec Max Combinaisons slip.


## The 6-number Combination

Example:
If you choose $1,2,3,4,5$ and 6 , you will obtain the following selections:

| $1,2,3,4,5,6, \mathbf{7}$ | $1,2,3,4,5,6, \mathbf{1 1}$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| $1,2,3,4,5,6, \mathbf{8}$ | $1,2,3,4,5,6, \mathbf{1 2}$ |
| $1,2,3,4,5,6,9$ | $\ldots$ |
| $1,2,3,4,5,6,10$ | $1,2,3,4,5,6, \mathbf{5 0}$ |

Each board will generate 44 selections of 7 numbers from 1 to 50 valid for the Lotto Max and/or the Québec Max, according to the game(s) selected. The 3 boards will give you a total of 132 selections ( 44 plays of 3 selections).

## The 8 -number Combination

## Example:

If you choose $1,2,3,4,5,6,7$ and 8 , you will obtain the following selections:

| $1,2,3,4,5,6,7$ | $1,2,3,5,6,7,8$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| $1,2,3,4,5,6,8$ | $1,2,4,5,6,7,8$ |
| $1,2,3,4,5,7,8$ | $1,3,4,5,6,7,8$ |
| $1,2,3,4,6,7,8$ | $2,3,4,5,6,7,8$ |

Each board will generate 8 selections of 7 numbers from 1 to 50 valid for the Lotto Max and/or the Québec Max, according to the game(s) selected. The 3 boards will give you a total of $\mathbf{2 4}$ selections (8 plays of 3 selections).

## The 9-number Combination

Example:

| If you choose $1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8$ and 9, you will obtain the following selections: |  |
| :---: | :---: |
| $1,2,3,4,5,6,7$ | $1,2,3,4,5,7,9$ |
| $1,2,3,4,5,6,8$ | $1,2,3,4,5,8,9$ |
| $1,2,3,4,5,6,9$ | $\ldots$ |
| $1,2,3,4,5,7,8$ | $3,4,5,6,7,8,9$ |

Each board will generate $\mathbf{3 6}$ selections of $\mathbf{7}$ numbers from 1 to 50 valid for the Lotto Max and/or the Québec Max, according to the game(s) selected. The 3 boards will give you a total of 108 selections ( 36 plays of 3 selections).

## The cost

The cost for 3 combinations, per draw, and according to the quantity of numbers of your combinations (6,8 or 9 ), is as follows:

| Lotto Max | $\$ 220$ | $\$ 40$ | $\$ 180$ |
| Lotto Max + Québec Max | $\$ 308$ | $\$ 56$ | $\$ 252$ |
| Québec Max | $\$ 88$ | $\$ 16$ | $\$ 72$ |

## The prizes

For each game, a winning combination can result in several prizes:

## Here are some examples:

For a 6 -number combination valid at Lotto Max or Québec Max, with 2 winning numbers out of 6 , the ticket would win you 5 prizes in the $3 / 7$ category.

For a 8 -number combination valid at Lotto Max or Québec Max, with 6 winning numbers out of 8 , the ticket would win you 2 prizes in the $6 / 7$ category and 6 prizes in the $5 / 7$ category.
